It is a toll worth paying, but to pay the price to reach the addicts broken and shattered by sin and not capitalize on raising up a generation of youth behind them that can contribute in ways their parents could only dream is short-sighted. The first generation gets the family out of Egypt, but the second can bring us into the Promised Land where young people experience lifelong victories for which their parents could only pine! Preachers from the floor began to commit to host youth rallies and now we will enjoy a total of five before youth camp next year. Hallelujah! What a joy to co-labor with servants of God here on our Reservation that have a heart for reaching the Promised Land Generation!

RADIO STATIONS FOR THE RESERVATION

It has long been on my heart to get involved in radio ministry. By God's grace He connected us with an organization that helped us apply for nine different radio frequencies across the Reservation. Please pray that these applications will be approved and that God will guide us as we set the precedent for establishing stations in the interior of the Reservation. Christian radio has perched on the outskirts of Navajoland using private land as broadcast points. This project will be unique in that we will place towers on the Reservation to reach areas untouched by Christian broadcasts. Our desire is to co-labor with our brethren to develop a cohesive programming that will benefit the overall work of God across Navajoland. This level of organization and technological expertise is beyond me, but not beyond my God. He is gracious to keep me humble by pressing me into projects that require complete dependence upon Him! I covet your prayers.

RAISING THE BAR AT MISSIONS CONFERENCE

Thank you for praying for our missions conference at Strong Hold Baptist Church in Pinon. Our speaker had the hand of God upon him to preach the Word! As the conference approached, people and plans seemed to fall apart undermining months of preparation and in the few hours leading up to the first service God seamlessly put everything back in place. He's so good to remind us that He is in control! By conference end, the church committed to give over \$20,000 to Faith Promise Missions!
