NAVAJOLAND BAPTIST REVIVAL 2025

One of the ministries the Lord will allow me to continue spearheading through NBM is our Navajoland Revival Meeting. I established this meeting 13 years ago to stir up Revival on the Navajo Nation and by God's grace it has grown to become a marquee event on the Reservation! This year we had a high attendance of 438 on Tuesday Night from 9 different Native American Tribes! Churches cooked food, brought their church choirs, hosted soulwinning groups from out of state in the morning times and brought van loads of people from their churches. There were 4 souls saved, a number of young people surrendered to ministry and the future structure of the ministries across the Reservation were clarified. It was a powerful meeting! In the future, I will host this meeting at Ganado Baptist Church and bring Bible College Students to attend and consider whether God would have them surrender to Native American Missions.

YOUTH CAMP REUNION RALLY

Solid Rock Baptist Church, our first church plant, hosted the annual Youth Camp Reunion Rally and did an incredible job. This is an event that Fabi and I organized over the years and were so encouraged to see Pastor Jones Wauneka step up with his congregation and take on this responsibility. So many of our brethren are absorbing new responsibilities! There were over 130 young people in attendance at this rally.

GREAT CONFERENCE IN KENAI, AK

I took 4 young preachers from the Navajo Reservation with me to Kenai, Alaska. God blessed this Missions Conference with Pastor Caleb Cinereski. There were 3 souls saved during the conference, great attendance and an encouraging time of planning with Pastor Caleb about how Trinity Baptist Church and NBM can help make a reality his desire to start a Bible College on the Road System in Alaska. This would be crucial infrastructure to help support our ultimate goal of helping to plant training institutes in the Native Bush Villages. Please pray with us as we pursue a partnership with this good man of God and his church, toward the goal of training choice servants to impact all of Alaska's church planting efforts!

REACHING THE EASTERN AGENCY OF THE NAVAJO NATION

I just finished preaching the missions conference for one of our Ganado Baptist Bible College graduates, Pastor Aaron Nelson. Wednesday night of the conference 2 precious souls responded during the invitation by calling on the Lord for salvation! On Monday night of the conference a 20-year-old young man named, Lane, surrendered to preach and will start Bible College this Spring! Crownpoint Baptist Church is a key church in the overall work of reaching Eastern Navajoland. On Tuesday of the conference, Pastor Nelson took me to three sites where he is planning to start churches. Each site is on private land that checkerboards into the Navajo Nation. This land unlike Reservation property, can actually be purchased and owned by a church itself! What's more exciting is that Pastor Nelson has 5 young men in his church surrendered to preach as well as 4 young ladies in the Bible College!
