Dear Pastor, Church and Praying Friends,

WHAT IS THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF NBM?

As we approach the end of 2025, I cannot help but simultaneously praise the Lord for all He has done while also considering what goals should be set and endeavors pursued in 2026! I am seeing clearly with every passing day that God has relocated our family to Arlington, TX for the ultimate purpose of consolidating the ministries of our home church with our work on the Navajo Nation and among the Alaskan Natives. The ultimate goal of NBM is to enable the planting of a Gospel Light in or near every one of the 574 Tribes in our Nation! Why is this important? In my lifetime on the Navajo Reservation, I have observed the impact Native people can have when participating in Tribe-to-Tribe evangelism endeavors and church planting. I am confident that the growing number Native American believers are an untapped resource for reaching tribal people across the globe! If we reach the 574, we open doors and unlock impact opportunities all over the world!

ALASKA – GREATLAND BAPTIST MISSIONS

In 2026 we will launch the Alaskan arm of Navajoland Baptist Missions. Alaska is an Aleut word meaning “great land”. In cooperation with some incredible missionaries in Bush Alaska we are launching Greatland Baptist Missions as the ministry banner under which we will seek to **1.** Start a Road System Bible College that will support multiple Bush Village Institutes and Missions Training Centers for both Natives and those who desire to minister to them. **2.** We will pursue an open door to plant a church in the villages of Stebbins and St. Micheal, AK with the assistance of Missionary Micheal Forss in Unalakleet, AK. **3.** We will organize and conduct Evangelistic Basketball Camps, Vacation Bible Schools, Constructions Groups, Institute Teaching Modules and much more. We believe that what God has done among the Navajo can also take place among the precious Alaskan Native villages. **4.** Provide financial scholarships for young men training in Bible College who desire to become a missionary bush pilot in Bush Alaska.

WHAT’S THE GOAL IN NAVAJOLAND?

NBM will continue to **1.** Partner with Navajo pastors and Bible College students to plant churches and evangelize other tribes and tribal people groups. **2.** Aid in the securing of properties and planting of churches with the young preachers that have graduated from Ganado Baptist Bible College **3.** Connect churches with opportunities to take Mission Trips to work on the Navajo Nation. We have connected eight churches for trips in 2026! **4.** Build a dormitory to accommodate Bible College students from other tribes and the surrounding area. **5.** Establish Christian Schools in the churches that have been planted on the Navajo Nation. **6.** Host the Navajoland Baptist Revival, Navajoland Baptist Youth Camp and the Navajoland Baptist Youth Revival.

HOW YOU CAN HELP?

Please continue to pray for the Haynes Family. I traveled to Pinon, AZ on the Navajo Nation for a Prayer and Planning Meeting on December 22nd. I spent time with the Navajo pastors as we met with Alaska Missionary Israel Warren to prepare for the Yukon Gospel Excursion taking place in July of 2026. We will take a group of young preachers nearly 900 miles down the Yukon River over a couple of weeks to influence these young preachers, evangelize the lost and seek church planting opportunities among the Athabaskans. We are targeting 16 villages and leveraging the relationship between Athabaskans and Navajos as an inroad to access these villages. We need your prayer and financial support in this work now more than ever. It’s going to be an exciting year in 2026!
