YOUTH CAMP INFORMATION

WHERE: Solid Rock Baptist Church Grounds in Nazlini, AZ

WHEN: June 22nd - June 25th, 2026 (Monday - Thursday)

*Groups may arrive on site as early as 1:00pm, but no later than 2:00pm to be unpacked in time for [Counselor Orientation at 3:00 pm and Camper Orientation at 4:00pm.](#)

WHO: Young people ages 8-12 and *qualified* counselors.

*Counselors need to be age 19 or older. Counselors should be ready soulwinners, faithful servants in their local church with the full recommendation of their local pastor to minister to young people with discretion and spiritual maturity.

COST: \$75 per camper + spending money for concession stand, and camp offering.

WHAT TO BRING

- Play clothes for the week
- Two or three sets of church clothes
- Sleeping Bag
- Cot/air mattress (girls dorm only)
- Pillow and a blanket
- Tennis shoes and church shoes
- Towels and wash cloths for the week
- Large “Beach” towel for swimming
- Soap and shampoo
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Dirty clothes bag
- Modest Swimwear (colored T-shirt and long basketball shorts)
- Plastic bag for wet clothing
- Bible and pens or pencils
- Extra money for snacks during the week
- Extra money for the camp offering



THINGS NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP

- Electronic devices (radio, mp3, games, etc)
- Earrings or necklaces on boys
- Clothes with unchristian themes
- Body piercings for boys, girls or counselors
- Cells phones of any kind
- Hand-held computers (I-pads, tablets, etc)
- Comic books, magazines, novels, etc
- Fireworks, firearms, or knives

CAMP DRESS CODE

Boys:

- Long pants and shirts must be worn at all times (*Basketball shorts may only be worn during swim time*).
- “Dress” or “casual” pants and a collared shirt are required at all classes and services.
- No boy will be allowed to wear any type of sleeveless shirt to any activity.
- Boys will be allowed to wear casual sleepwear in the dorms only!

Girls:

- Dresses/skirt and blouse are required attire at all classes and services.
- No sleeveless dresses or “low-cut” blouses or dresses will be allowed at any time.
- All dresses and skirts must be below the bottom of the knee even when sitting.
- Only split skirt (culottes) will be allowed at the activities. Absolutely NO pants or gauchos allowed!
- Girls will be allowed to wear casual sleepwear in the dorms only.
- No swim suits for swimming. Long colored T-shirts and basketball shorts are allowed.

GENERAL RULES

1. Every instruction of camp leadership and counselors must be followed promptly, respectfully and without argument.
2. All dormitories must be clean before the first morning service.
3. There will be no practical jokes, roughhousing, disruptive behavior, or vandalism of camp property. Any damage to camp property will be the financial responsibility of the individual involved.
4. All services and activities must be attended unless a camper is excused by a counselor or camp leader due to illness.
5. Personal music devices, cell phones, tablets, and video games are not permitted. Any such items brought to camp may be confiscated until the end of camp.
6. A daily rest time must be observed by all campers. Everyone must rest in their bed quietly with no talking or leaving the dorm.
7. *No* bodily contact will be allowed between boys and girls at any time. Boys will not visit the girl's dorms, nor will the girl's visit the boy's dorms.
8. Separate swimming will be maintained for boys and girls; spectators of the opposite gender will not be allowed at the swimming hole.
9. Girls are required to wear a dress/skirt and blouse to all classes and services. Absolutely no shorts, jams, or pants will be allowed on girls. Boys must wear shirts at all times. No tank tops, shorts, or net shirts will be allowed. Clothing that is immodest (revealing or form fitting) or displays inappropriate or worldly messaging (rock t-shirts, alcohol, etc.) is not allowed.
10. Girls and boys will be required to wear modest, appropriate sleepwear as determined by camp leadership in the dorms .

Camp leadership reserves the right to enforce additional rules as needed. Failure to follow these rules may result in dismissal from camp at the parent's expense.
